Responder's Rebids Opposite Opener's 1-Suited Rebid Notes

Opener's 1-suited rebid limits their hand in strength (usually about 11-14 hcp) but leaves a variety of different shape options. They usually have a 6+card suit.

 - o @ 3-level
- Raising Partner
- Jumps to Game
- NT Bids
- Jumps to 4-Level in new suit
